Dear Faithful People of God

Grace and peace to you! I have heard from many of you how exciting it is to see so many young children in our midst. Indeed, the Lord has blessed our faith community with many wonderful and precious children of God. Each of them have wonderful gifts they bring to the ministry we are called to do *together*.

Children are such a joy to be around and clearly Jesus had an affinity for children. Perhaps, it was because they were so vulnerable in His day and as the Biblical account tells us God always stands alongside the weak, oppressed, marginalized, and powerless. Yet, I often wonder if Jesus wasn't also drawn to children because they have such a unique way of looking at life. They are so trustworthy, loving, honest, and eager to learn. I suspect in His continual arguments with the religious leaders, with the unbelief of even His closest followers, with the hatred that began to mount as His ministry grew, and as the fear and anxiety He surely experienced as His impending death drew near Jesus found escape in the children that came to Him. He saw in them joy and goodness; the very same joy and goodness God created them from. I imagine some of these children came to Him laughing, smiling, and singing. And I suspect some of these children came to Him crying, screaming, and kicking. I imagine some of these children came in nice clothing for their day; however, I suspect many came in tattered clothing and smelled rather putrid. No matter how they approached Jesus continued to say, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them." That is God's call to us as a faith community as well. Let the children come (because they are part of the kingdom). Let the children's voices be heard (because their voices matter). Let the children be seen (because Jesus' eyes are set upon them). Let us not hinder them (because Jesus commands it). Each and every child, youth, and young adult at Bethany matter! Each of them is special! Each of them is valued! Each of them has unique gifts that make us stronger *together*. Let us be grateful, thankful, and joyful for God bringing all the young people at Bethany to us to be part of our life *together*. Let us *together* build them up and not hinder them.

I hear so often what a joy it is they are here and how we want them to remain a part of our life *together*. Yet, sadly, from time to time I hear stories of how they



**Called to Order:** 6:30 pm

**Pastor's Report:** 17 pastoral visits made. Trunk or Treat event had lower attendance this year. Positives to note for this month: First Communion celebrated, many visitors attending services, lively adult Sunday School sessions. Upcoming vacations will be Thanksgiving week (not Sunday), and the Sunday after Christmas.

**Secretary's Report:** Moved for approval by Kent Kaufman, seconded by Candy Madsen.

**Treasurer's Report:** Income is still higher than anticipated. \$1502.09 was given to the West Branch Lions for the Hoover Food Packaging Event. \$500.00 will be moved to the Quilter's Fund from the Bus Tour Fund. Moved for approval by Jenni Olson, seconded by Kent Kaufman.

**Education Report:** Courtney Heid and Amber Marsh are working on the selection of a Christmas program.

**Fellowship Report:** none


