## **Fourth Sunday Supper**

A free meal and time for fellowship provided to anyone. This is open to the entire West Branch community.

## **Quilters**

This faithful group of women meet every Tuesday from 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. in the Great Hall. They make quilts that bring comfort, warmth, and healing to those in need.

## **Tanzania Sister Congregation**

Through our partnership with the Southeastern lowa Synod of the ELCA we have a relationship with the Mbakweni Lutheran Church. In the past Bethany members have visited Tanzania and we have provided funds for a corn milling machine.

## **Kids Against Hunger**

In the past Bethany has done several events to package food for hungry children locally and internationally.

### **Others**
