Since 1983, Shelter House has provided safe shelter and helped people improve the quality of their lives as they move beyond homelessness. Shelter House began in an old home in Iowa City with a capacity of 29 sleeping spaces including beds, couches, and mats on the floor. Today, Shelter House operates a 70-bed emergency shelter in addition to four homes and an apartment building through which they provide 47 permanent supportive housing units.
