We come to pray for the healing of the nations and for the healing of our own lives and communities.


#### We come at Christ's invitation.

And I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.


And I heard a voice from the throne saying, "See, the home of God is among mortals.

Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb, through the middle of the street of the city.


On either side of the river is the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, producing its fruit each month; and the leaves of the tree are healing of the nations.

Hear our cries, receive our prayers, and fill us with your blessing, until needy no longer, your whole creation sings your praise, through your Son, Jesus Christ.


