John 18:33-37 Christ the King Sunday November 21, 2021

There is no manuscript for today's sermon. In brief, the basis of the sermon is on listening to Jesus, the way, the truth, and the life. Having a baptism this morning, I hearkened back to Jesus' own baptism and the word of God calling down out of heaven saying, "This is my Son, the Beloved; with whom I am well pleased." I hearkened back to that same voice calling down from the mountain at Jesus' transfigurations for the disciples to hear that said, "This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him."
