Baptism and the paschal candle

Lydia and her family became God's children when they were baptized.

Making the sign of the cross on our foreheads can remind us that in baptism we become God's children, too.



This is a paschal candle. Say it like this: PASS-kull. During the Easter season, the paschal candle reminds us that the risen Jesus is with us. Do you see a paschal candle near the place where people are baptized in your church?
