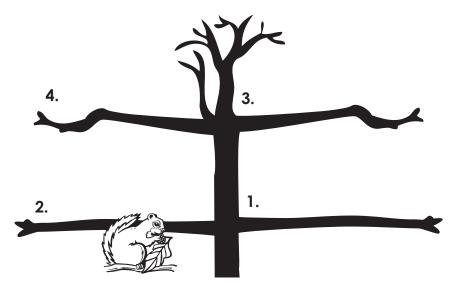
Help the squirrel climb this tree by answering each quiz question below. Each time you answer a question right, the squirrel can move up to the next branch.
