Imagine welcoming Jesus into your home as Zacchaeus did. Set a place for Jesus at the table.

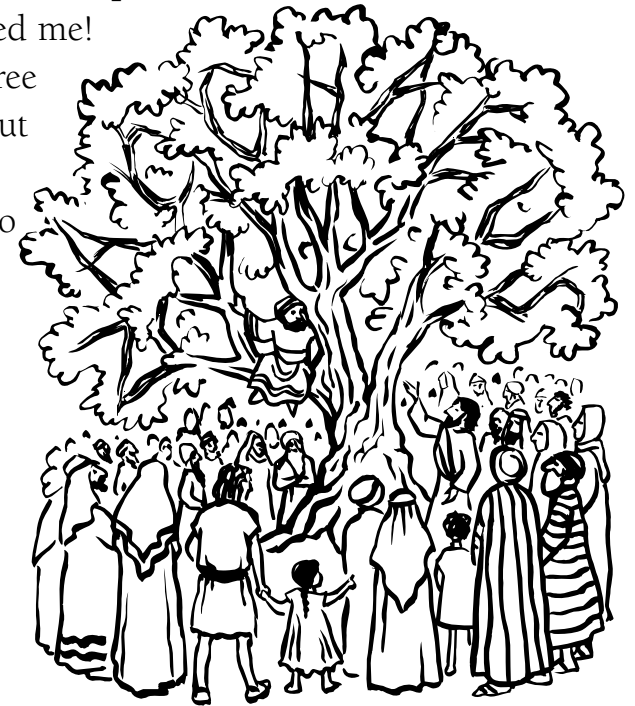

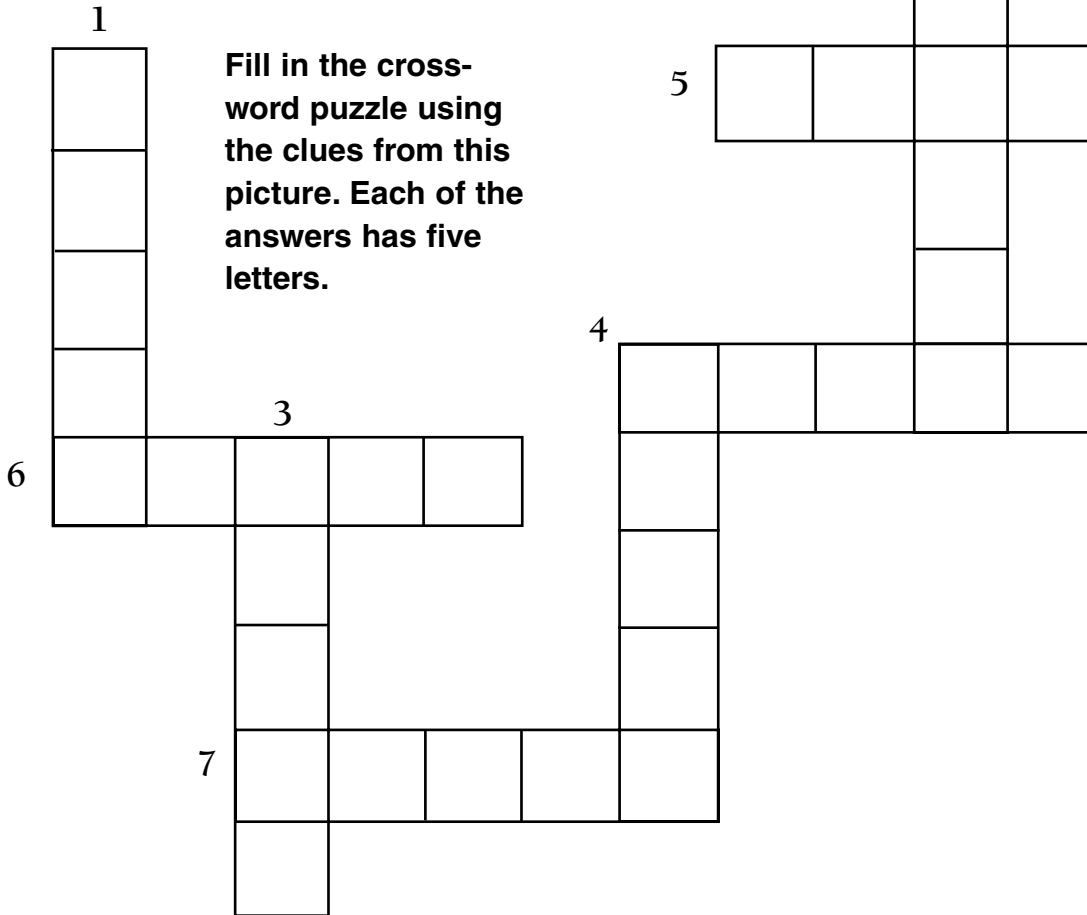


Who am I? My name is hidden in the tree, just like I am.
