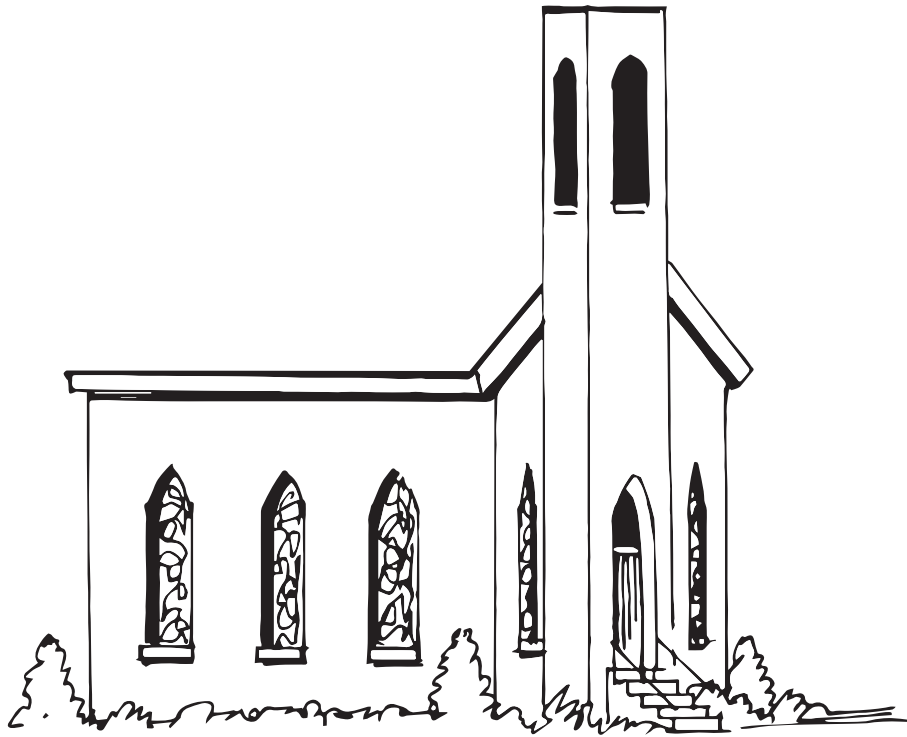


# From the Rooftops

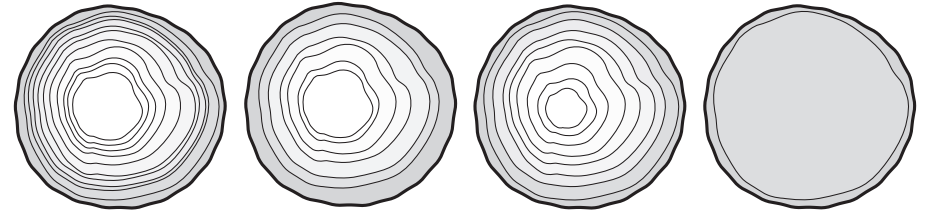

Pentecost 4

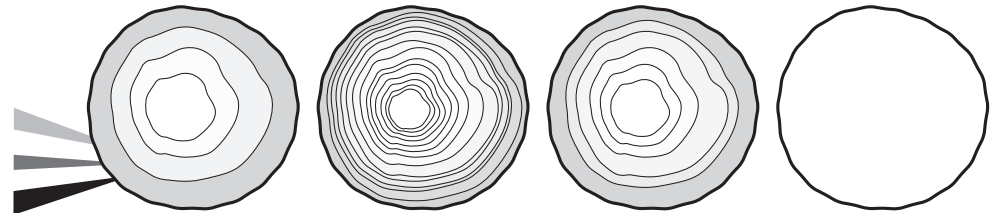
- Today is the **fourth** Sunday after Pentecost.

We can tell how old trees are by the number of rings in their trunk. Count how old these trees are. Then draw rings for how old YOU are!

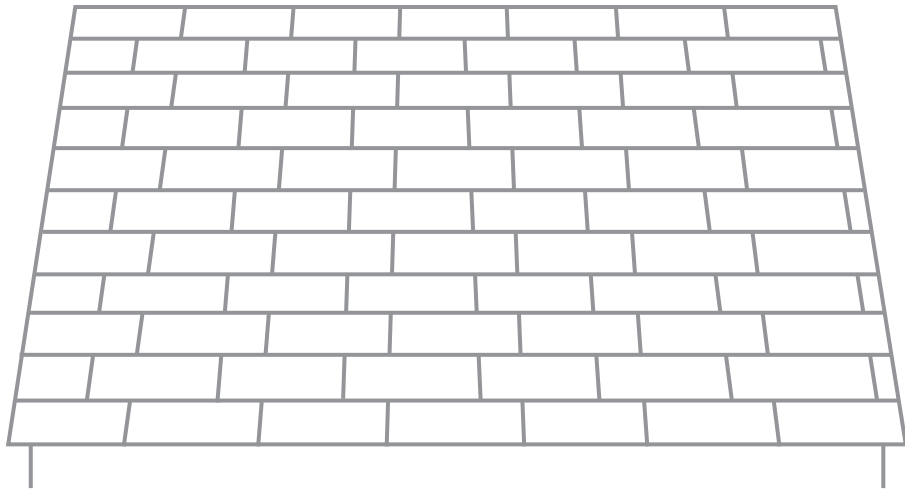
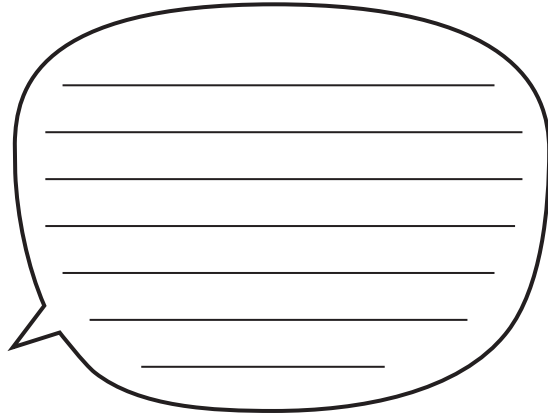
