*For older children and teens:* Print enough copies of the *Greatest Grandparent Award* with the sentence stems for all the grandparents in your family.

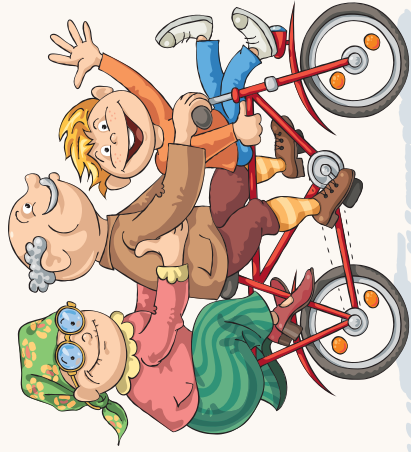
## CREATE
