

Food Pantry News

In 2024 the WB Food Pantry and the Paw Pantry combined in one location (the old middle school), and now serves all in West Branch. The much larger space provides for a greater variety of foods and non-SNAP essentials, as well as refrigerated and frozen foods!

Uniting the two has also meant the doubling of staff, so that clients can visit weekly to meet their needs, rather than monthly as in the past. Bethany and the pantry are now both drop-off locations for donations.

Many thanks to all who faithfully donate, and to those who help with the monthly deliveries!

In 2024 Bethany delivered 225 bags of food, and the pantry served 18 families per week.




