We are about to embark on the season of Lent. During Lent we often focus on the ways in which we have turned from God and given ourselves over to the ways that lead to sin and death. Repent-

ance and the need for God's forgiveness is a theme of Lent. God invites us to return yet again to God and give all we have to God. Give God our anxieties, fears, wrongdoings, and struggles. We do this trusting God receives all, hears all, bears all, and ultimately forgives all we give to God through the grace extended to us through Christ's death and resurrection.

At the recent *Faith Forward* event that helped us leap into Lent, we invited attendees to "Give it to God." A box with slips of paper greeted people as they entered and they were invited to write something they need to give to God. This box will remain in place during the season of Lent. It is located on the *Faith Forward* table in the hallway. See the sign below that explains this spiritual practice.

Do you need to give to God today?

Do you need to let go of & let God during the 40 days of Lent?

PROMPTS TO HELP

**Give it to God:** One thing I've done wrong & need God's forgiveness for is...

**Give it to God:** Something I worry about & need God to take from me is...

> **Give it to God:** A fear I have & need God's help with is...

**Give it to God:** Something or someone I am angry with & need God to help let me go of is...

#### WRITE & DROP

Use as many slips of paper as you need. Drop it in the box and give it to God. team invites all to stop, write, and drop whatever it is on your heart and mind into the box. Then, offer a silent prayer naming what you wrote and concluding with, "Lord, in your mercy, hear my prayer. Amen." In doing so, you will be fulfilling one of the five faith promises of *Faith Forward*: prayer.

It is lit during the Easter season, on Pentecost, at baptisms and funerals.
